

It's finally here! There are just a few more things to do to make sure everything's perfect

ONE MONTH LEFT UNTIL YOUR WEDDING DAY

- ___ Apply for your marriage license
- ___ Apply for park/picture permit
- ___ Book & Confirm your final wedding gown fitting. It's helpful to have a bridesmaid with you to learn how to bustle your train and fasten any tricky buttons (and help you go to the bathroom, if you've got a big wedding dress!)
- ___ Check with your bridesmaids and groomsmen to make sure they've gotten their attire, confirm arrival times, and answer any last minute questions
- ___ Contact your vendors (Wedding Planner, Décor, Caterer, Officiant, Wedding or Cup Cake Company, Photographer, Videographer, Florist, DJ, Musicians, Transportation and or Hotel), to confirm arrival and delivery times.
- ___ Write and print your wedding program
- ___ Create welcome baskets or bags for out-of-town guests
- ___ Send change-of-address information to post office (if you are moving into a new home as husband & wife)
- ___ Write thank you cards as you receive wedding gifts (from those guests who won't be attending)
- ___ Contact any guests who have not RSVP'd (you may want to enlist your mother or mother-in law to help out with this)
- ___ Plan your rehearsal dinner, get wedding party gifts ready, pick out your outfits

THREE TO TWO WEEKS BEFORE YOUR WEDDING DAY

- ___ Arrange seating/floor plan and provide a copy to your venue and décor company
- ___ Write seating place cards/or complete seating board
- ___ Give your final head count to your venue, caterer, décor and florist, and confirm any last minute details
- ___ Visit all your vendors and provide last minute details and final balances
- ___ Write your toast for your wedding rehearsal dinner and wedding reception
- ___ Try on your wedding shoes, and wear them on carpeted surfaces around the house (time to break those puppies in.....pack pretty slippers just in case your feet collapse before you do)!
- ___ Arrange for a house sitter/pet sitter/babysitter while you are on your honeymoon
- ___ Pick up your wedding dress (yeah....your almost there)
- ___ Attend your bachelor party or bachelorette party, if you're having one
- ___ Send your travel plans and contact information to a family member and your house sitter (in case of emergency). Confirm flight and take off information as well as transportation plans to the airport or bus terminal.

7-3 DAYS BEFORE YOUR WEDDING

- ___ Do something to relax, like enjoy the company of your out-of-town guests/friends, go for a massage or just hide (whatever works)
- ___ Assign responsibilities to your wedding party (handing out corsages and boutonnieres, greeting and seating guests, checking on vendors.....or just get a wedding planner to do it all for you)
- ___ Have a manicure and pedicure (or go for a tan and start your honeymoon early)
- ___ Rehearse ceremony
- ___ Give your wedding party their gifts

- _____ Hold the rehearsal dinner
- _____ Bring seating cards/board, wedding favors or donation thank-you cards, reception trinkets, engagement photos, packaged goodies for each of your guests and or any other items that need to be dropped off at your venue.
- _____ Give the best man or maid of honor your gift/love note for your future husband or wife (so that they can open a little something from you before the ceremony to let them know you love them...ahhhhh)
- _____ Pack your bags for your honeymoon or for the night of your wedding
